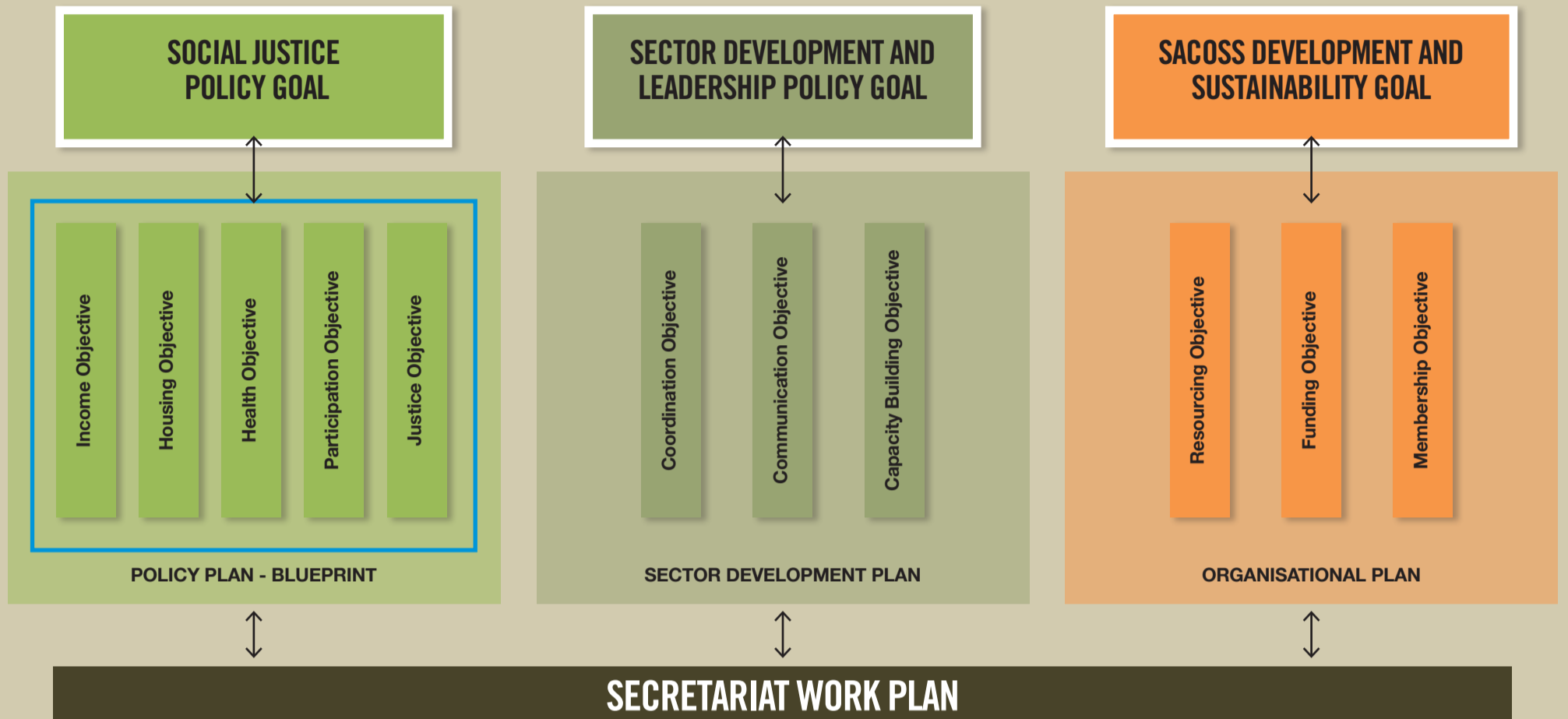
# STRATEGIC PLANNING FRAMEWORK
