

# SACOSS Essential Services & Disability Conference 2018 – Travel and venue guide

## Parking

Conference guests are able to receive a special parking rate of \$14.50 per day at Wilson Parking car parks located at Adelaide Oval (refer to the map on page 4).

**Wilson East Car Park** - Entry via King William Road.

**Wilson North Car Park** Entry via Pennington Terrace, North Adelaide through the Bob Quinn Gate.

To receive the special conference guest rate of \$14.50, guests will need to validate their ticket **before leaving the venue** using the machine in the Cathedral Room; otherwise the public rate is \$5.00 per hour.

Car parking is limited and available on first come, first serve basis.

Alternatively, there is limited ticketed on street car parking nearby and some guests may choose to walk over the Riverbank Footbridge, entering from the Telstra Plaza on War Memorial Drive.

**Access Parking** (blue permit) - the most convenient place to park with an access permit is Wilson East Car Park, entry from King William Road. Turn right after entering the car park and drive to the end of the row (heading north), then turn right again and loop back in the other direction. There you will find 7 blue permit spaces situated next to the lifts. Take the lifts to level 3 for the Cathedral Room. Remember to validate your ticket to receive the \$14.50 day rate.

## Taxis and Drop-off Zones

The nearest taxi rank is located on the western side of King William Road.

There are also access transport drop-off zones on War Memorial Drive and King William Road (refer to map on page 4).

## Public Transport

The Oval is accessible by various bus, train and tram services. Please visit [adelaidemetro.com.au](http://adelaidemetro.com.au) for more details.

## Access


- All main entries to Adelaide Oval are accessible for wheelchair users, semi-ambulant visitors and those accompanied by assistance dogs

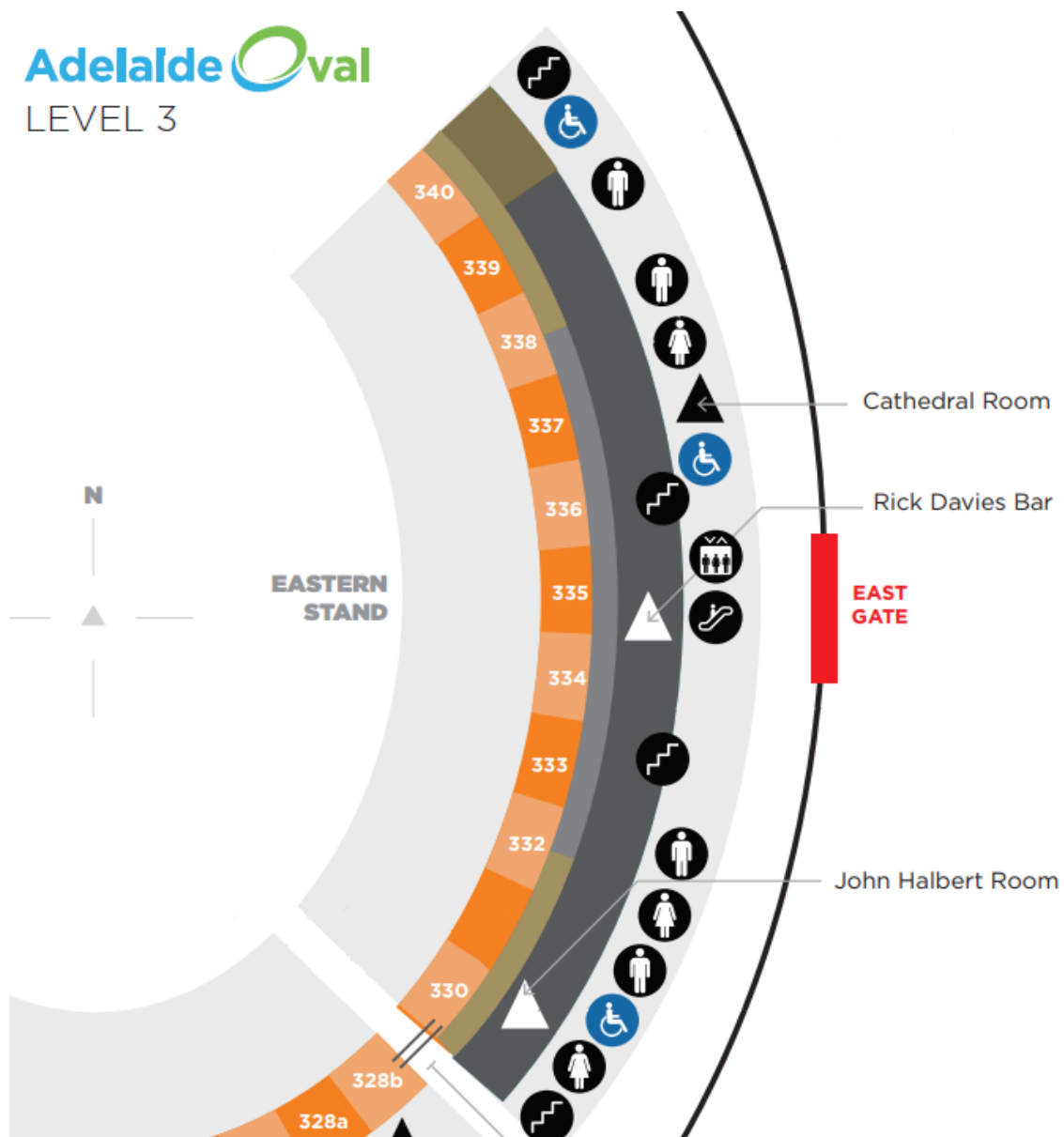
You will be provided a username and password which will also be emailed to you. Hit the **Return to Login** button and enter these credentials, you will now be connected with your free Wi-Fi.
