The #HereForSA campaign was developed to recognise, promote and build pride in the community sector.

We think it's time to give them a public shout-out – to show our support to the people who support South Australia.

IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA

- There are 37,000 people working in community services
- Community workers represent 4% of the South Australian workforce
- There are 765 organisations registered within the sector
- There are 54,209 community volunteers
- The total sector revenue is \$2.996bn, which is around 2.7% of the state economy (Gross State Product at current prices)

The campaign will feature workers and volunteers across the entire sector including those in: crisis care, aged care, community childcare, charities, social work, disability, mental health, child and family wellbeing, emergency relief, community centres, First Nations' support and advocacy, youthwork, homelessness, community legal centres, financial counselling and domestic violence support.

We want to highlight and celebrate employees and people who volunteer in not-forprofit community organisations: from support workers, advocates, carers, social workers, youthworkers and counsellors, to drivers, receptionists, policy officers, cleaners, customer service officers, CEOs, event organisers, finance officers, managers – and everyone else too!
